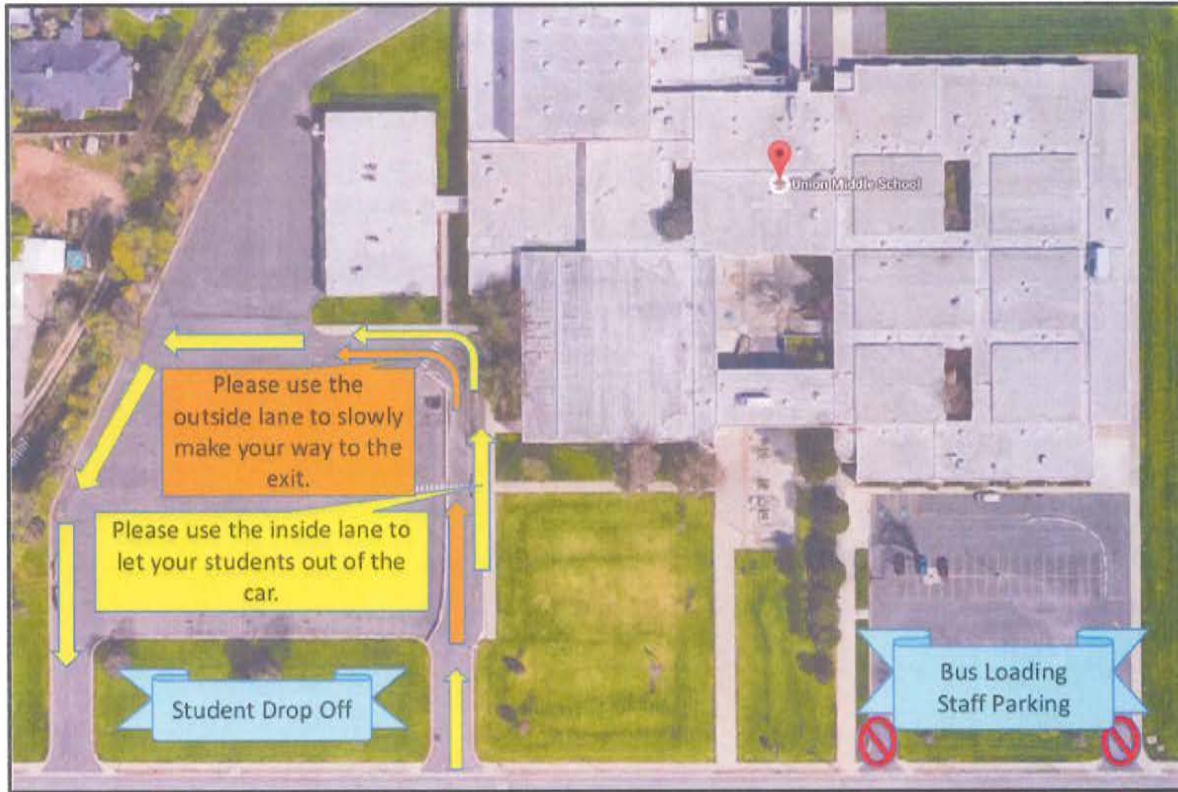


School Bus Loading and Unloading and Parent Drop-Off and Pick-Up





Text Description of Walking Routes

All students living East of 1300 East should use a collector street to walk to 1300 East then proceed to the nearest traffic signal at 7745 South, 7490 South, 8020 South/High Point Parkway or 8600 South. Students will then be able to cross 1300 East at a crosswalk. Students should proceed on collector streets to the nearest stoplight on 700 East, located at 7800 South, 8000 South or 8600 South and cross at the crosswalk. Students should proceed along 700 East until arriving at the school.

All students living East of 700 East should use a collector street to walk to the nearest stoplight on 700 East. Stoplights are located at 7500 South, 7800 South, 8000 South or 8600 South and students should cross at one of these crosswalks. Students should then proceed along 700 East until arriving at the school.

All students living West of 700 East, South of 8000 South and East of the East Jordan Canal should use collector streets to Bryce Drive (500 East), Romaine Drive or 535 East. Using these streets students should proceed to 8000 South and cross 8000 South at 500 East to the nearest school entrance.

Students living West of the the East Jordan Canal and South of 8000 South should use collector streets to 150 East and Angel Street. Students should proceed North along either of these streets to 8000 South. Upon reaching 8000 South, student should walk East to 500 East to cross 8000 South and to the nearest school entrance.

Students living north of 7800 South should use collector streets to 7800 South and proceed to a crosswalk located at 280 East, 450 East or 700 East. After using the crosswalk student should proceed to the nearest school entrance.

Parents/Guardians dropping students off before school or picking them up after school are encouraged to use the lower parking lot west of the school. They should enter the "Entrance Only" access and exit from the "Exit Only" access. When picking up students in the lower lot, parents/guardians are encouraged to load and unload students in the lane nearest to the sidewalk and use the outer lane for entering and exiting the load and unload zone. Parents should be vigilant during the pick-up and drop-off process and drive no faster than 10 miles per hour while on school property.

Students should not be dropped off or picked up in the upper lot unless they are being checked out/checked in during the school day. The upper lot is for bus loading and unloading before and after school.

We encourage parents to walk the routes to school with their students to make sure students are aware of the safest routes to follow. Those students who are eligible to ride busses should do so. The bus provides the safest way to travel to and from school for those students who live in a bussing area.
