1. Bylaws Review – Kelly Tauteoli - A few changes have been made by the state.
  - a. 1. No Co-Chairs, but can be a Vice-Chair.
  - b. Chair must be from a parent group
  - c. Voting on things must be by a majority vote
  - d. Parent’s interest survey will be going out in July
  - e. Changed May to April
  
2. Data leading toward our CSIP for 2019-20
  - a. Our CSIP goal is to have 85% of students reporting feeling connected to school on our survey questions
  - b. Student interest surveys
    - i. Asked multiple questions and how students felt. This helps us know how connected to Union they are.
  - c. Teachers rate each kid on a 1-4 scale on how well they know each student.
    - i. Teachers put in place a system to make sure all students are feeling connected and included at Union.
  - d. In schools with similar demographics as Union Middle School, we ranked the top in student growth for Math. We ranked 4<sup>th</sup> in Language Arts. Showing growth in Science.

- e. New version on state report cards for schools. There aren't any grades anymore and there is more emphasis on English Language Learners.
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- 3. Student Data Interviews with administrators and counselors (update)
    - a. Counselor and Administrator met with every student. Students set goals for where they want to go and how to approach it.
    - b. Very positive point of connection with another adult in the building.
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- 4. District Dress Code Policy
    - a. District revisited the dress code policy and have some proposed changes.
    - b. Currently there is specific language to address the concerns.
    - c. The revised policy has room for interpretation
    - d. Community standards are being taken into account
