### Parent/Student Guidelines

Guidelines for student learning during School Dismissal:

- Learning Activities are optional.
- Learning Activities are a review for previously taught content.
- Learning activities outlined in the Instruction Guide and school plan are not graded--HOWEVER, assignments assigned before the closure and turned in during the closure should be graded and entered into the grade book
- Teacher grade level teams may provide optional student content learning activities.
- Additional resources will be listed in Canvas or Google Docs and easily accessible to parents/students. We will also post information on the school website.
- Print materials will be provided for pick up in the main office for families who do not have internet/printing capabilities.
- Weekly communication from teachers will come through emails or Canvas.
- Address questions to the teacher through email or phone messages. Response time--no more than 1 school day.

Daily Expectations for all Students	<p><b>Daily expectations for all students:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Literacy--Read for 30 minutes two times a day (60 minutes total) from text/texts of choice and complete a reading reflection (more information below).</li> <li>● Quiz Retakes are available on canvas. If you have missing work or retakes for Quarter 3, you can complete those items at this time.</li> <li>● Elective Courses--See your elective course digital learning plan for more information on your coursework. (It is an additional document that we sent you.)</li> </ul>

<p>Learning Activities</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Complete all learning activities online on canvas or on a hard copy that can be picked up from the office. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ <b>Science</b> - Complete the assignment in the Science Challenges Week 1 (3/18-3/20) module on canvas. Make sure to complete Part 1 and Part 2.</li> <li>○ <b>Math</b> - All students complete Review #1 and can work on i-Ready. The extension activity is Planning Recipes (Unit 2 review). Everything can be found in “At Home Learning March18 – March 20” module on Canvas. Hard copies are also available at the front office.</li> <li>○ <b>Social Studies</b> - Please complete the Nearpod activity assignment in the Canvas module for this week. An alternate assignment is available in the Main Office.</li> <li>○ <b>ELD Students:</b> If you are an ELD student, you are required to log in to your Read 180 Student Application and complete 30 minutes of online work.</li> <li>○ <b>ELA Students:</b> You are expected/required to choose a book to read an hour a day, and then complete one of the reading reflection assignments on Canvas per day. They are located under Modules&gt;At Home Learning Plan (March 18-March 27th). You can access a hard copy of these assignments in the main office.</li> </ul> <p>To complete these assignments you can choose a book you have at home, one you chose from the library, you can log in to Canvas where your teachers have uploaded audiobooks and PDF books, or you can come to the Main Office at Union Middle School to retrieve a free book to take home.</p> <li>○ <b>Regarding Library Books:</b> If you have checked out a book, all late fees are waived until we return to school.</li> </li></ul>
<p>Daily Expectations for all Literacy Lab Students (Students that Have a reading Class.)</p>	<p><b>Daily expectations for all students with a reading class (This will help you improve!):</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Read Your independent Reading book for 30 minutes two times a day (60 minutes total) from text/texts of choice and complete your reading log.</li> <li>● Use the reading log template to write your own reading log down or pick up a hard copy at the school.</li> <li>● <a href="https://drive.google.com/a/csddocs.org/file/d/1nH4FPCSN7QMI76tWqKazuig9gClrHT7m/view?usp=sharing">https://drive.google.com/a/csddocs.org/file/d/1nH4FPCSN7QMI76tWqKazuig9gClrHT7m/view?usp=sharing</a></li> <li>● If you left your reading book at school you may read any other book, collect your independent reading book from the front office, or read an online book from read180 or any other online reading app.</li> <li>● Spend 20-30 minutes on the Read180 or System 44 app 2-3 days a week.</li> <li>● Log into Google with your csddocs.org log in, this will lead you to click on the box of dots (waffle). You can then log into the Read180 or System 44 Student Application app.</li> </ul>
